Emergency & Evacuation

We NEED MORE CAPTAINS!!

If you are interested in becoming a captain, please contact park staff. Training for captains will be offered as needed.

SRCC is divided up into 16 “areas”. This is for emergency purposes. Each area has (ideally) two (2) captains for approximately 12-15 homes in each area. If an emergency occurs, all Captains are notified. If there is electrical power in the park you will be notified by ONE CALL. This call goes out to ALL Captains to the registered phone number you have given the office. If there is NO Electrical power, If you perceive that people in your area may be in need, **All Captains should report to the Clubhouse as soon as possible after making sure their own family is safe. Your safety is most important, first and foremost.** Each set of Captains will be given a red Area bag, a hand radio and a checklist. The captains’ responsibilities are to check on the assigned area homes, determine if the residents are home and if they need assistance.

If an “Evacuation Warning” has been given and you feel comfortable doing so, safely check on your assigned area. Be sure to inform residents of the Warning. If any residents do need assistance, contact the Park Staff at the clubhouse through your radio. If it is an emergency, call 911 directly. If the phones are not working, be sure to clearly state over the radio that you have an emergency, the type of emergency, your location and that you

need 911 contacted. DO NOT GIVE OUT SPECIFIC NAMES. Once all your assigned homes are secured, return to the clubhouse with your bag, radio and checklist before you evacuate.

Your duties are complete at that time. If you wish to help out further, please let staff at the command center (most likely the clubhouse) know. Extra help is always appreciated. **It is not your responsibility to do any CPR, First Aid, fire-fighting or anything beyond what an average citizen would do in any emergency.**




Your help and support during a time of need can make a big difference for your neighbors and help out the first responders as well. ***If an Evacuation Order has been given, you will not be expected to stay behind to perform your duties. Please evacuate as quickly as you safely can.***

We have a CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) and medical first aid kits with trained volunteers to help out until professional first responders arrive. (This is different from being an AREA captain.) If you are interested in becoming a CERT volunteer, academies are held locally, contact the Valley Center Fire Protection District business office at 760-751-7600.
