Skyline undergrounding project looks at December completion

San Diego Gas & Electric Company's Skyline Ranch undergrounding project, which began in August of this year, is scheduled to be completed in December 2020.

SDG&E estimates that traffic delays on the 5.5 mile project may occur due to occasional lane reductions, temporary restrictions or lane closures required during construction. As part of these activities, temporary traffic control may be required along the area of interest.

There will be multiple construction locations and activities taking place simultaneously, with

work hours, traffic control measures, and noise restrictions for each area dictated by the appropriate local jurisdiction.

The project is part of the utility's "ongoing efforts to reduce wildfire risk and the impact of Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) during extreme weather conditions." SDG&E told The Roadrunner, "Once completed, the undergrounding work will enable community facilities to remain powered during PSPS events."
