"Did you know that Skyline Ranch Country Club has two separate golf courses?

The Skyline Ranch Country Club course is a 2818 yard/par 58 course from the men's (Blue and Yellow) tees and 2623 yard/par 60 from the Ladies' (Red and White) tees.

The Skyline Ranch Country Club – SCGA course is a 3069 yard/par 60 course for the Men and 3015 yard/par 60 for the Ladies'. The course is marked on the tee boxes by Red Medallions for the front nine and Yellow Medallions for the back nine.

If you would enjoy a little longer (about 250 yards) and more challenging round of golf without leaving the park, then joining the SCGA may be a good option for you.

Parking In The Park



- ♦ INOPERABLE VEHICLES MAY NOT REMAIN ON ANY LOT, STREET, GUEST PARKING AREA, OR RV LOT. ONLY PROPERLY LICENSED AND AUTHORIZED VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED WITHIN THE PARK.
- NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THE STREET IS ALLOWED, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE LOADING AND UNLOADING OF AN RV FOR A MAXIMUM OF 24 HOURS.
- NO PARKING IS ALLOWED IN VACANT LOTS OR ANY OTHER NON DESIGNATED AREA AT ANYTIME.
- ♦ ALL PARK RESIDENT VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED WITHIN THE PARK RESIDENT'S CARPORT, DRIVEWAY, AND/OR GARAGE OVERNIGHT.
- ♦ GUEST PARKING IS FOR GUESTS ONLY. IT IS NOT TO BE USED BY RESIDENTS AS EXTRA PARKING SPACE.
- ♦ VEHICLES MUST BE OFF THE STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11 P.M. AND 6 A.M.

Management would like to address some common questions concerning the sewage maintenance charges.

The costs are calculated annually by determining the maintenance and operation costs from the preceding 12-month period and are spread out to all homes in the community over a twelve (12) month period.

The costs cover the maintenance and operation to this important area of our community.

Although the maintenance and operations costs were higher than previous years, the charges are based solely upon the expenses from the prior year. The charges are solely for reimbursement of maintenance and operation costs.
